1. Standing opposite a partner:

 Clap your own hands and then pat your partner's opposite hands to the beat

2. Whenever we sing "last day of September":

• Perform a repeated pattern: Clap, pat, touch shoulders, touch thighs for "last day of Sept," then pat twice for "tember."

3. First verse:

• Clap and pat to the beat.

4. "Ally Ally Oh":

- Each time: Clap, pat, touch shoulders, touch thighs (repeat x3).
- Pat twice on the last two syllables of "September."

5. "Captain says":

• Salute the captain.

6. "Never never do":

• Shake finger from side to side and shake head as if saying "no."

7. "Big ship sank":

Clap and pat to the beat

8. "Bottom of the sea":

• Point down with both fingers.

9. "Dip our heads":

• Turn around with backs to each other and look through your legs at the other person.

Educational Focus: This clapping game enhances motor skills, rhythm, coordination, listening skills, social interaction, and cognitive development through structured movements and Click the links partner interactions.

- 1. "The big ship sails on the ally-ally-oh"
 - Action: Row back and forth.
- 2. "The ally-ally-oh, the ally-ally-oh"
 - Action: Rock side to side or bounce.
- 3. "The captain says it will never, never do"
 - o Action: Salute the captain and shake finger and head.
- 4. "The big ship sank to the bottom of the sea"
 - o Action: Raise child on knee and drop/bump to the floor.
- 5. "Dip our heads to the bottom of the sea"
 - Action: Put your head in your child's tummy and tickle with your head or fingers.

Educational Focus: This activity enhances gross motor skills, rhythm, coordination, social and emotional development, and promotes bonding through interactive play.









Silent Singing with Actions

- 1. Sing the song in your head, only singing out loud the word "September."
- 2. **Pick a word** or words beginning with a certain letter (e.g., 's'):
 - Each time you reach that word in the song, perform a specific action (e.g., clap when you sing a word beginning with 's').

Educational Focus: This activity enhances listening skills, attention to detail, and phonemic awareness. It also improves **self-control and memory** as children need to follow the song internally and perform specific actions at the correct moments. Additionally, it promotes cognitive flexibility by combining silent singing with physical actions.

Paddling Pool in the Garden

Make a paper boat and sail it in your paddling pool or in the bath and sing the song

Education Focus: This activity promotes holistic development by engaging multiple senses and cognitive skills including fine motor skills, scientific exploration and **creativity and imagination** while providing a fun and enjoyable experience.

Standing up in a Circle

1. First verse:

 Holding hands in a circle, walk around.

2."Ally Ally Oh":

• Each time, move arms up and down to make waves.

3. "Captain says it will never, never do":

- Walk into the middle and shake your finger and head as if saying "no."
- 4. The big ship sank to the bottom of the sea":
 - Holding hands or noses, crouch down.

5. "Dip our heads to the bottom of the sea":

 Turn around with backs to the center of the circle, look through your legs to others across the circle, and wave.

Educational Focus: This activity enhances gross motor skills, coordination, and spatial awareness. It promotes social interaction, teamwork, and following instructions. Additionally, it encourages imaginative play and physical movement, contributing to overall physical and social-emotional development.
